Summary of Material Modifications

Dear Plan Participants:

At their meeting on March 22, 2013, the Board of Trustees made the following revision to your medical plan effective July 1, 2013. The following replaces the last paragraph on page M-12 which begins with the phrase, "Medical Benefits After Termination of Coverage":

Extension of Medical Benefits After Termination of Eligibility (page M-12)

Medical benefits after termination of eligibility may be continued following the 6-month extension described on pages E-2 and E-3 to a totally disabled individual for covered charges related to the condition causing the disability that are incurred during the calendar year in which such 6-month extension ends and for the next following calendar year. However, if sooner, benefits shall end on the earlier of the date the disabled individual:

- is no longer totally disabled; or
- has access to other group health coverage or governmental coverage (including, but not limited to, Medicare or Medicaid), whether in their own right or as a dependent of another individual.

To receive these benefits, the individual must contact the Administrative Office and submit proof of total disability within 60 days after eligibility ends.

A participant who is eligible for both COBRA and an Extension of Medical Benefits After Termination of Eligibility (Extended Benefits) may choose either to self-pay through COBRA or to receive Extended Benefits through the Plan. Extended Benefits cannot be elected following COBRA coverage.
